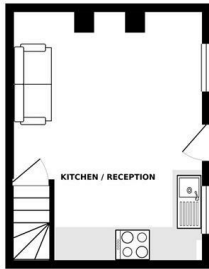

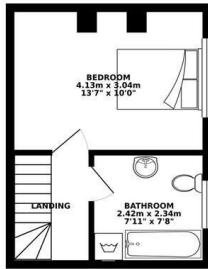

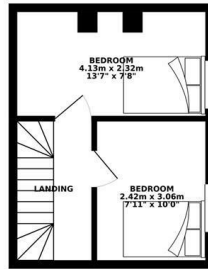
GROUND FLOOR 22.22 sq. m.

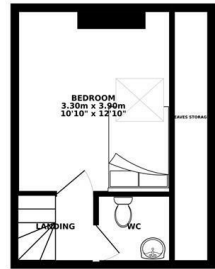
1ST FLOOR 22.22 sq. m.
